## Computer Programs Seized En Route to the Soviet Union

STOCKHOLM, Nov. 28 (AP) — Two shipments of United States computer programs that were believed to be intended for use with computers illegally headed for the Soviet Union have been intercepted here, customs authorities said today.

The programs and the Digital Equipment Corporation VAX 11/782 computers, which were seized earlier in Helsingborg and Malmo, constitute war matériel when used together, the Swedish radio said. United States law forbids shipment of such equipment to the Soviet bloc.

The latest discovery was made at the end of last week, according to Bjorn Ericsson, head of customs, and "resulted from the increased customs control that followed the seizure of American computer equipment in Helsingborg." The deliveries arrived separately, one by air and one by ship, but were clearly connected and have the same Swedish consignee, Mr. Ericsson said.
