50 Students Suspended

BERKELEY, Calif., Oct. 24 (UPI)—The University of California late today threw out of school 50 students who were arrested earlier in the day when the police broke up a sit-in behind barricades at a classroom building.

Mr. Heyns said the 50 students among those arrested would be suspended immediately, and a recommendation would be made that they be expelled after a hearing under the university's discipline procedure.
