BERKELEY, Calif., May 26—Several hundred students at the University of California at Berkeley staged a protest march today into downtown Berkeley. It ended without incident.

A similar march attempted last week ended with the arrest of nearly 500 persons.

Today's march was in protest against the university's action in building a fence around a "people's park." The university had obtained the property for use as an athletic field but in April students and youths from a hippie colony near the campus decided to turn the lot into a park.
